

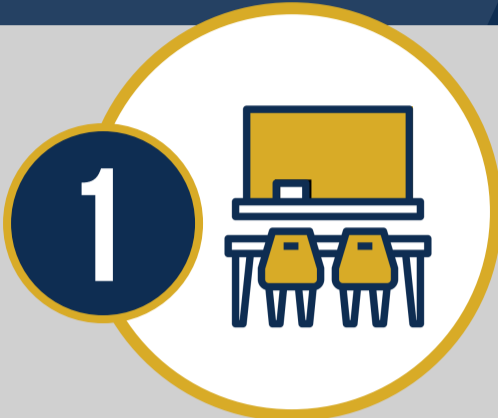
# WHEN TO WEAR A FACE COVERING



If you are **unvaccinated**, you are required to wear a face covering when indoors\*.

If you are **vaccinated**, pack a face covering with you when coming to campus. For the health and safety of our campus community, certain spaces require universal face coverings.

Face coverings are universally required in the following spaces:



## CLASSROOMS

This includes instructional labs or any other space where instructional activities are occurring



## HEALTH SERVICES LOCATIONS

Includes Student Health Services, WorkHealth Solution Clinic locations, and COVID-19 asymptomatic testing locations



## PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

This includes when riding in campus fleet vehicles, unless you are alone



## INDOOR GATHERINGS OF 50+

This includes academic, staff, student, and external events



## ECEC

If you are older than 2 years old, you are required to wear a face covering when indoors at the Early Childhood Education Center.



## WHEN POSTED

Certain facilities or events may require universal face coverings. Clear signage will be posted to inform you.

## RESPECT INDIVIDUAL CHOICES



Those who wear face coverings when optional, keep physically distant, and/or refrain from handshakes are doing what they feel is necessary to protect themselves or loved ones, and will be free from judgement in our Bobcat community.

\*Unvaccinated individuals may remove face coverings on campus-controlled property if: you are alone in a private office, eating or drinking and 6-feet away from others, or when in your private campus residence.
