


# Completing Your COVID-19 Attestation

1. Navigate to the WorkHealth Solutions employee portal [here](#). will be re-directed to single sign-on. Use your UCM ID and password to log in.

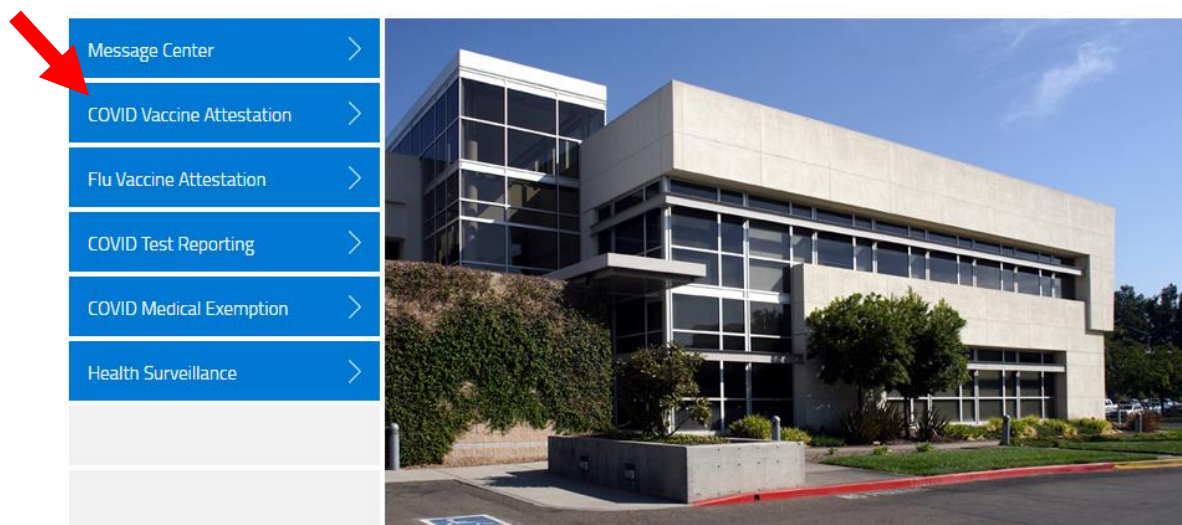
For security reasons, please Log Out and Exit your web browser when you are done accessing services that require authentication!

UC Merced and WorkHealth Solutions will treat the information obtained from CAIR2 as confidential medical information and it will only be accessed, used or disclosed as permitted by applicable laws and University of California policy. \*

I understand that if I do not authorize UC Merced and WorkHealth Solutions to verify my COVID-19 vaccination status from the CAIR2, I will be required to upload proof of vaccination into the health portal and my vaccination status will be verified manually by UC Merced and WorkHealth Solutions authorized personnel. \*

I understand that the information UC Merced and WorkHealth Solutions obtains and securely maintains from the CAIR2 will include all vaccination data associated with me stored in the California database. This includes the type of vaccine I have received in the past from a health care provider and the date the vaccine was administered. \*

To verify my COVID-19 vaccination status, UC Merced and WorkHealth Solutions will only use my name, date of birth, COVID-19 vaccination code, vaccine name, vaccine administration date(s), and vaccine completion status. \*

I understand I have the right to receive a copy of this form and revoke this authorization at any time. The revocation will not affect the use of the information already made in reliance on this authorization. I may exercise these rights by contacting COVIDresponseCTR@ucmerced.edu. \*
